Many of our family will still not feel it is the time to assemble due to personal health safety concerns. We encourage **EVERYONE** to make that choice freely and feel **NO OBLIGATION** to assemble. You will know when the time is right. In the meantime, please join worship via on-line streaming. This will continue indefinitely with coming improvements to quality and access.

For the time being, in-person worship will be limited to Sunday morning from 10:00 to 11:00 AM in the auditorium. Masks will be available, but we encourage you to bring your own if you have them. Personal communion "bags" will be available upon entry. You will be able to dispose of the individual cups as you exit. Giving boxes will be at all three exits for your contribution and all song books and Bibles will be removed from the pews for your safety. We encourage social distancing and ask that you sit with people you have already had contact with. Every other row will be blocked off and when we are dismissing, we ask that you do so from the back pews moving forward while keeping social distancing in mind. The auditorium and restrooms will be cleaned after every service. There will be **NO** Bible hour or children's classes until further notice. Unfortunately, this year's VBS has been cancelled as well. We will finish every service with two songs, but we will be singing "outside". Anyone who would prefer **NOT** to be exposed to those singing should certainly feel free to return home at that time.

We know this is **FAR** from normal. We still have a lot of adjusting in front of us, but our **GOD** is in control! Over the past three months, we have lost several of our dear family members. We want to continue to pray for and give comfort to those grieving. Please remember the families of:
