## I Don't Know What to Say...

It's Tuesday. I'm sitting at my desk writing the bulletin article for Sunday. By the time you read this, I'll likely already have preached the message. But, right now, I don't know what I'm going to say. I don't know what I'm going to preach.

Some weeks, I come in on Monday knowing exactly what I'm going to speak on the next weekend. Other weeks, it's an agonizing struggle that isn't resolved in some way until Thursday, or even later. Some weeks God gives me what I believe He wants me to say right away, then other times it's a confusing journey to the end and I'm still not sure when I get done preaching if that was it.

Ever have that happen? Not struggling to know what to preach, but knowing what to say?

Something I heard frequently in my dad's illness and death was people trying to express their sorrow for us but ending with, "I don't know what to say..." Sometimes, there are no words. Sometimes, we don't know what to say and that's a good thing because maybe there isn't anything to say. Another common scenario I hear people making this statement with is sharing the gospel. "I don't know what I'd say to them," so we just don't. Unfortunately however, unlike grief where it is appropriate at times not to say anything, that's not an option with the gospel. We don't get that choice. The Great Commission was given to everyone, whether or not you're a preacher.

So, what do we say? What should we do in moments where words fail us and we get nervous or feel awkward? We talked this past week about "making it count"—"it" being the opportunities we have for sharing the gospel with others. Jesus knew his disciples would feel the same way (after all, they were pretty scared guys and didn't even hang around when Jesus got arrested in the Garden). So, Jesus told them: "...do not be anxious about how you should defend yourself or what you should say, for the Holy Spirit will teach you in that very hour what you ought to say." (Luke 12:12)
