Find your ministry here—if it's not VBS, make it something else. Get plugged in. Don't be a pew potato—God wants to use you!

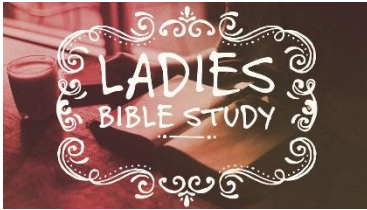
