

Marital Status: Married or Single?

Every time you apply for or start something, they want you to fill out a form: buying a car or house, applying for a new credit card, changing doctors, etc. One of the questions that always gets asked is your marital status: are you single, married, or divorced? It's hard not to focus on it when it's always asked. Our society fixates on relationship status and for many it becomes the way they identify themselves. Singles usually "feel" their singleness when in crowds because they don't have another person to be attached to. Married couples hear their married identity repeated to them when others use their names together: "Scott and Abby" or "Ben and Katey." Either way, single or married, a great deal of focus is given to our relationship status.

What if this isn't really how God intended for us to be identified? What if our identity is deeper and greater than our significant other (or lack thereof). Our world is obsessed with identity: sexual identity, relationship identity, gender identity, etc. The list goes on and on. It's almost like we don't know who we really are.

This morning, we'll wrap up our "Living as You Are Called" series by looking at what God thinks of us and how God wants us to identify ourselves. Having clarity on who we are goes a long way in dealing with the insecurities that come with living in a world constantly questioning identity.
